One Goal We Have as we Pray for Growth in Christ. (vs.11) 1. That God would be by us to be like Christ. "What he is doing is praying for revival. For if true revival is a work of God, if transforming and discerning love that enables believers to approve what is best is at the bottom the fruit of God's work in our lives, if true righteousness is fruit that comes through Jesus Christ, then however much God may use means, the means themselves do not guarantee anything. Only God can produce transformation; only God can grant a revival. So it is urgent that we ask God to work in us; it is vital that we learn to pray this prayer with Paul." -D.A. Carson
