A Better Priest

Big Idea: We can be confident with God because Jesus is our High Priest.

How can I be confident to approach God?

- 1. Jesus grants us ______ to God. (4:14; 5:1-5; 9:24)
- 2. Jesus grants us access to God on the basis of his _____. (5:1; 5:7-9)
- Jesus grants us access to God on the basis of his sacrifice so that we can approach God. (4:16)

"Because Jesus sits at the right hand of his Father in heaven, repentant sinners can approach the throne of God with boldness, no matter how filthy we feel. We can come when we have nothing to show for ourselves. We can come when we have just awakened from the stupidity of sin. We can come when so much inside of us feels cold and dead. And we can do so because we do not come on our own merits, but rather on the merits of Jesus, heaven's Great High Priest." -Scott Hubbard

Read the quote from Scott Hubbard again. What are some ways we might be prone to approach God based on our own merits rather than Jesus's?



How does Hebrews 4:16 help you to picture what is actually happening when you pray to God? How does this picture encourage you to pray and help you see what a privilege prayer is?

How does knowing that Jesus sympathizes with you and deals gently with you encourage you to go to Jesus in the face of suffering, temptation, and after you've sinned?

How can your own suffering make you a better comforter for others who are suffering? How can seeing and knowing your own sin enable you to help care for other people in their sin?

Why do we need a high priest who both gets us AND can save us; a high priest who understands us AND can supply what we need? What makes Jesus the perfect high priest who can do both of these things?

Why is it comforting to know that Jesus is interceding for us in heaven right now? How can truth give you confidence with God?

Look up the lyrics to the song "Before the Throne of God" and then listen to it. What are the lines in that song that stick out to you? How do they comfort you? How do they encourage you to hold fast to Jesus as your high priest?
