Benediction

1. Our remaining sin makes us Nervous.

2. His enduring Safety makes us Worship.

a. God *doesn't* guarantee He'll fulfill our wish list.

- b. God *does* guarantee our final deliverance. Verse 24
 - i. It's my deficiencies that make me delight in His competencies!
 - 1. God's _____: ...**able** to keep you from falling away...
 - God's _____: ...and will bring you with great joy into His glorious presence...
 - 3. God's _____: ...without a **single** fault.
 - 4. Philippians 1:6; Romans 14:4b; Romans 8:35-39

- ii. Give Him praise!
