What helps to motivate you to keep praying when you are tempted to give up? Where have you seen answers to prayers in your own life only after a long period of praying?

Out of the four action steps suggested, which one or two will you prioritize in your life?

Who are 1 or 2 people in your life that you are praying God would save? (If you are with a CARE Group take some time to pray together for all these people).
