To think about...

- What about your current physical body do you most look forward to leaving behind?
- The Bible records 10 different instances where Jesus appeared to someone or a group after he rose from the dead. Why do you think Jesus bothered? Why didn't He just immediately go back to His Father in heaven?
- While Christians will get new bodies at Jesus' second coming (1 Corinthians 15:23, unbelievers will not until a thousand years later (Revelation 20:5). The Bible doesn't tell us exactly what those bodies will be like, but does Revelation 20:11-15 help you draw any conclusions?
